



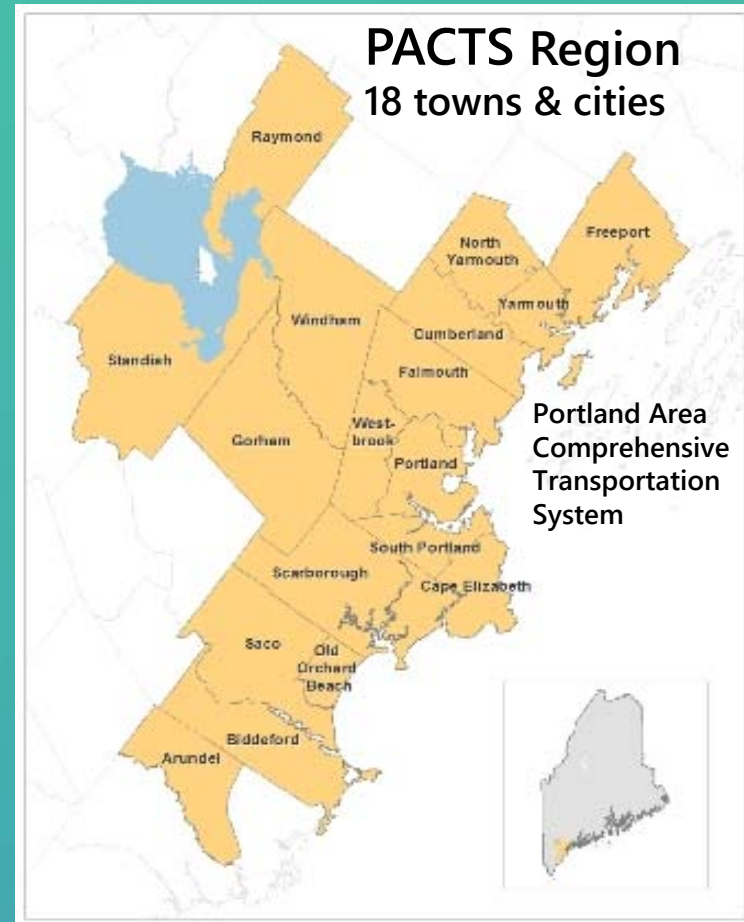

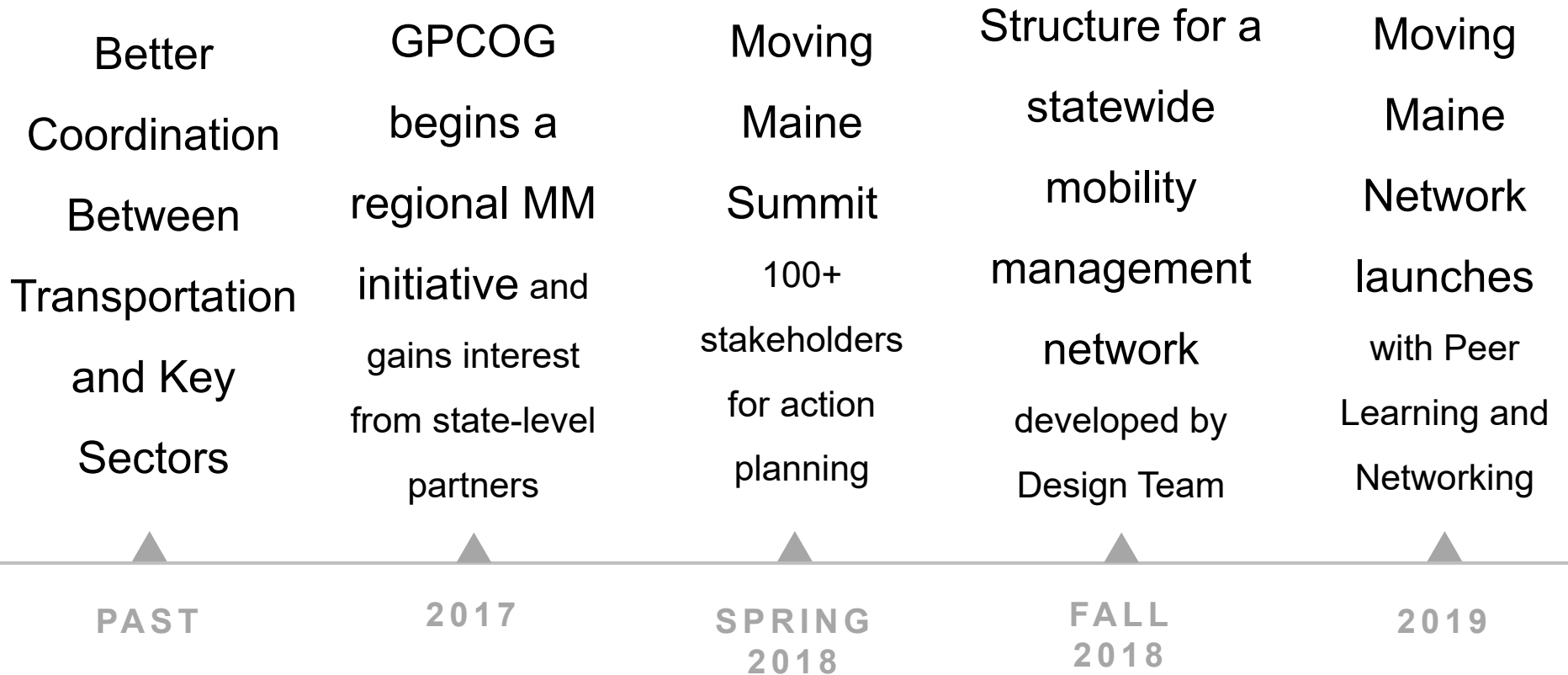

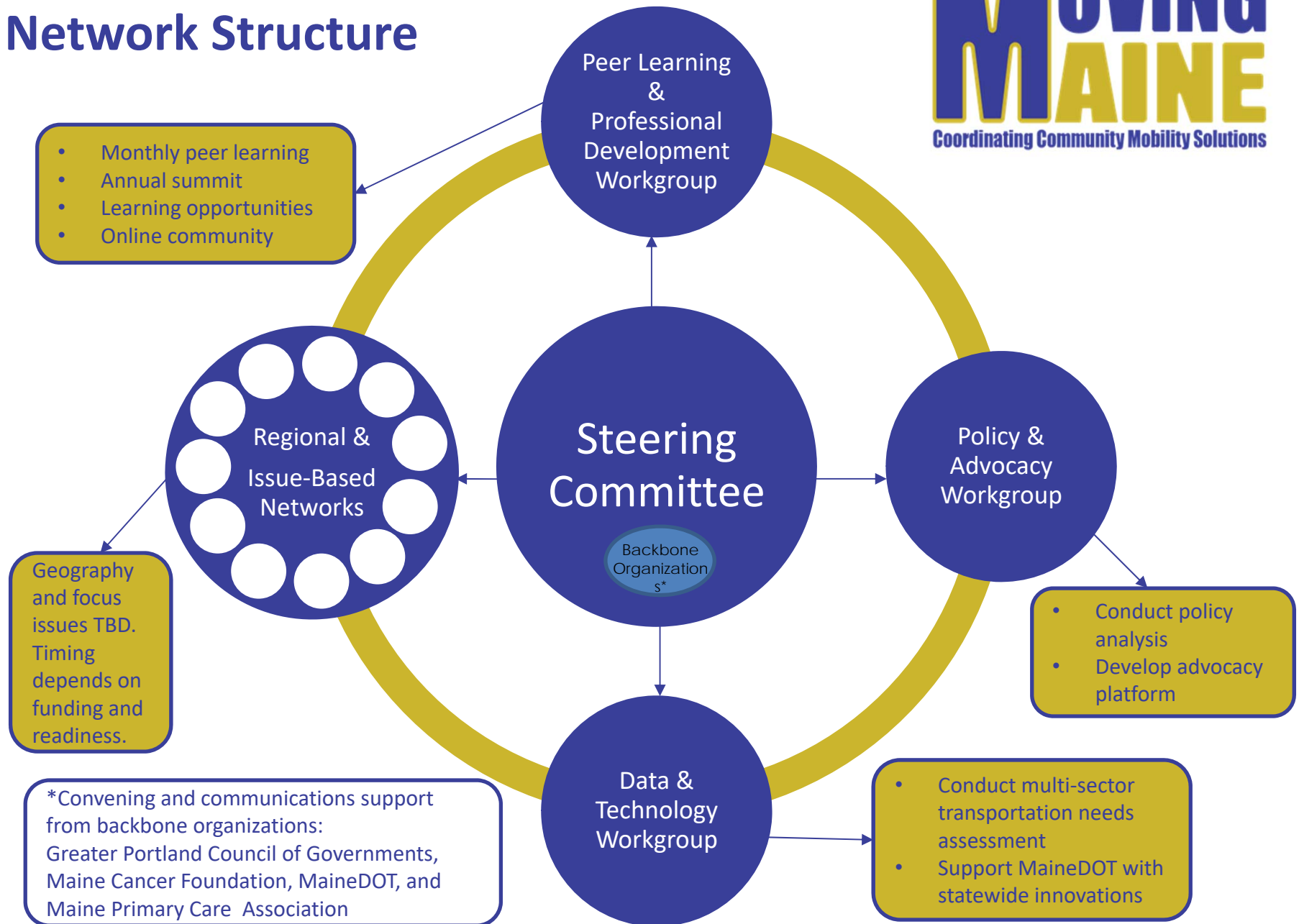
Mission

The Moving Maine Network will improve access to transportation for all, with a special focus on people with physical and logistical barriers.

Vision

- Stakeholders working on transportation access are well-connected, educated, and able to network with peers to improve the capabilities of the entire statewide mobility network.
- Mainers have access to affordable and convenient transportation resources.
- Maine has a robust network of mobility management programs providing support and coordination in all regions of the state.

Moving Maine Network Structure



BUILDING MOBILITY MANAGEMENT FOR MAINE: Statewide Network

- Maine's new Locally Coordinated Plan includes support for establishing the Moving Maine Network.
- Multi-sector Steering Committee kicked off in March – with commitment from 10+ organizations including MaineDOT.
- Partnered to submit FTA Access and Mobility Grants application – still waiting on notification.

Successes



BUILDING MOBILITY MANAGEMENT FOR MAINE: Statewide Network

- **BUILDING RELATIONSHIPS IS BUILDING CAPACITY.** Relationships put you in the right place at the right time.
- **UNDERSTANDING AND BRIDGING CULTURES IS ESSENTIAL TO MULTI-SECTOR COLLABORATION.**
- **COLLABORATION MAGNIFIES THE STRENGTH OF INDIVIDUAL PARTNERS.** The value of the network is in “knitting together” and catalyzing.
