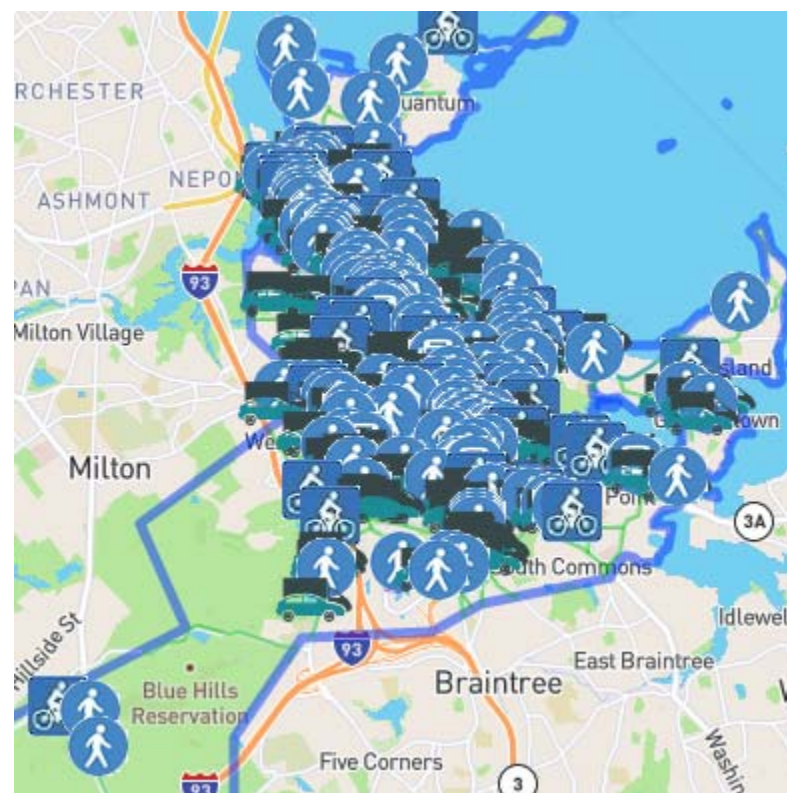
2019 FY Complete Streets Projects – Quincy

- McGrath Highway at Southern Artery Intersection Improvements
- Quarry Street Bicycle Accommodations
- Granite Street Bicycle Accommodations
- Coddington Street Pedestrian/Bicycle Safety/Mobility Improvements



Public Input

- Process to develop Tier 2 Plan – hundreds of responses in interactive survey
- Once projects are selected and designed, more input from residents, political leaders, and advocacy groups



Bidding Process

- Tier 3 Application is in, funds are awarded....what's next?
- Working with MassDOT guidelines for bidding to ensure funds are reimbursed.
- Differences between MassDOT procurement and City procurement

Constructability

- How does our project fit in with other projects around the City and other department priorities?
- Utility work, existing paving plans, make it difficult to execute other projects



Maintenance

- New treatments such as protected bicycle lanes a first for the City
- Coordination of street sweeping, plowing, and other roadway maintenance activities



Moving Forward

- Tier 2 Prioritization provides a list of future projects
- Useful for capital improvement planning
- Can be used to identify mitigation needs related to development within the City
