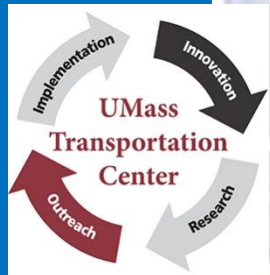

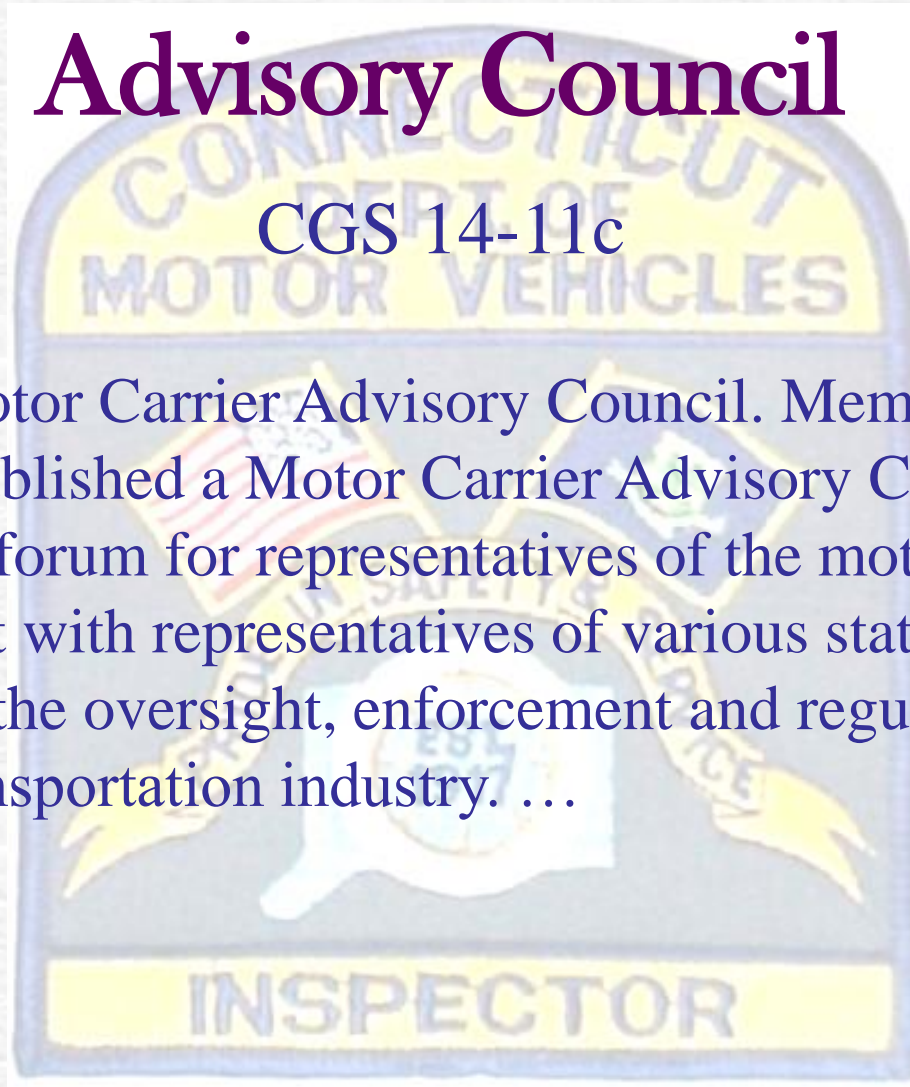

CGS 14-11c

Sec. 14-11c. Motor Carrier Advisory Council. Members. Duties.  
(a) There is established a Motor Carrier Advisory Council, which shall serve as a forum for representatives of the motor carrier industry to meet with representatives of various state agencies responsible for the oversight, enforcement and regulation of the commercial transportation industry. ...

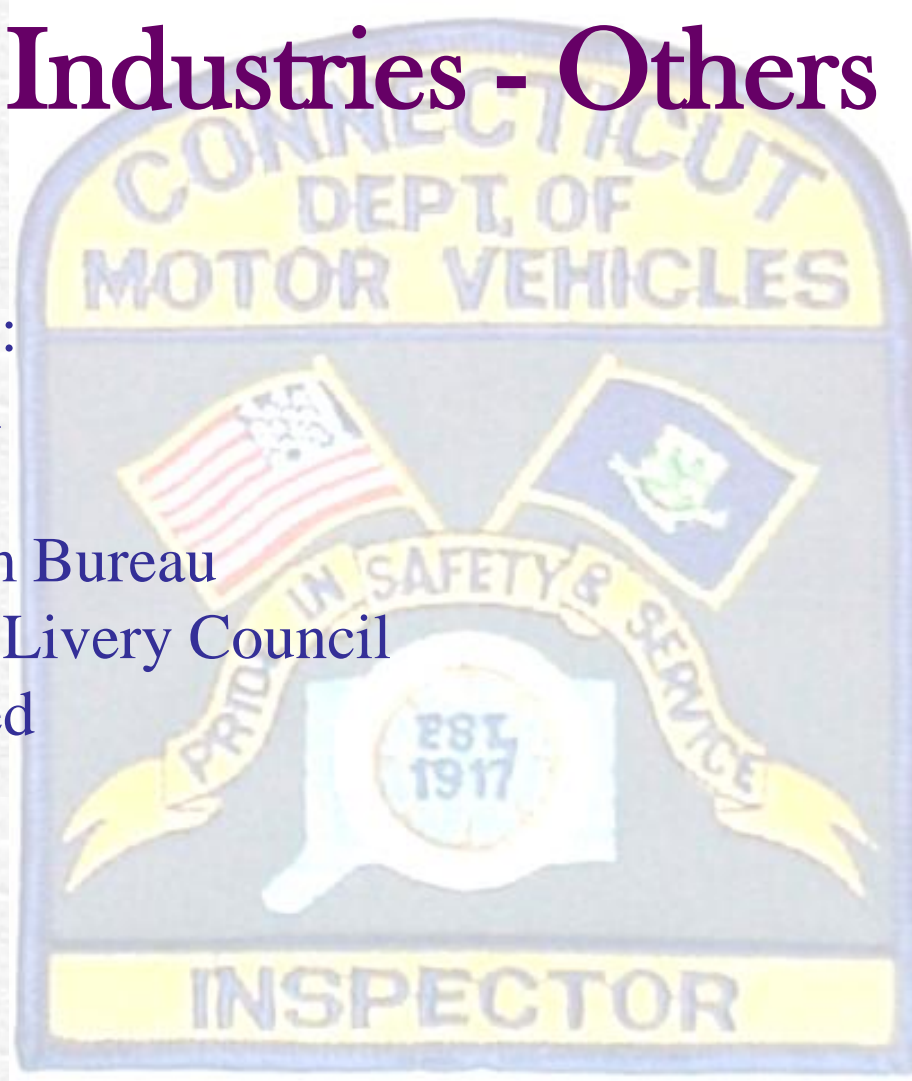

## Advisory Council

### recommendations

The council shall: Make recommendations ...

- (1) To eliminate the duplication of work
- (2) To promote uniformity of enforcement policies
- (3) To encourage the consolidation of the state's efforts to regulate and oversee ... the feasibility of consolidating  
- forms, decals, permits, registrations
- (4) consider the intrastate and interstate effects of state policies on the ability of Connecticut motor carriers to compete with motor carriers based in other states
- (5) consider and make recommendations concerning any other matter deemed relevant by the council.

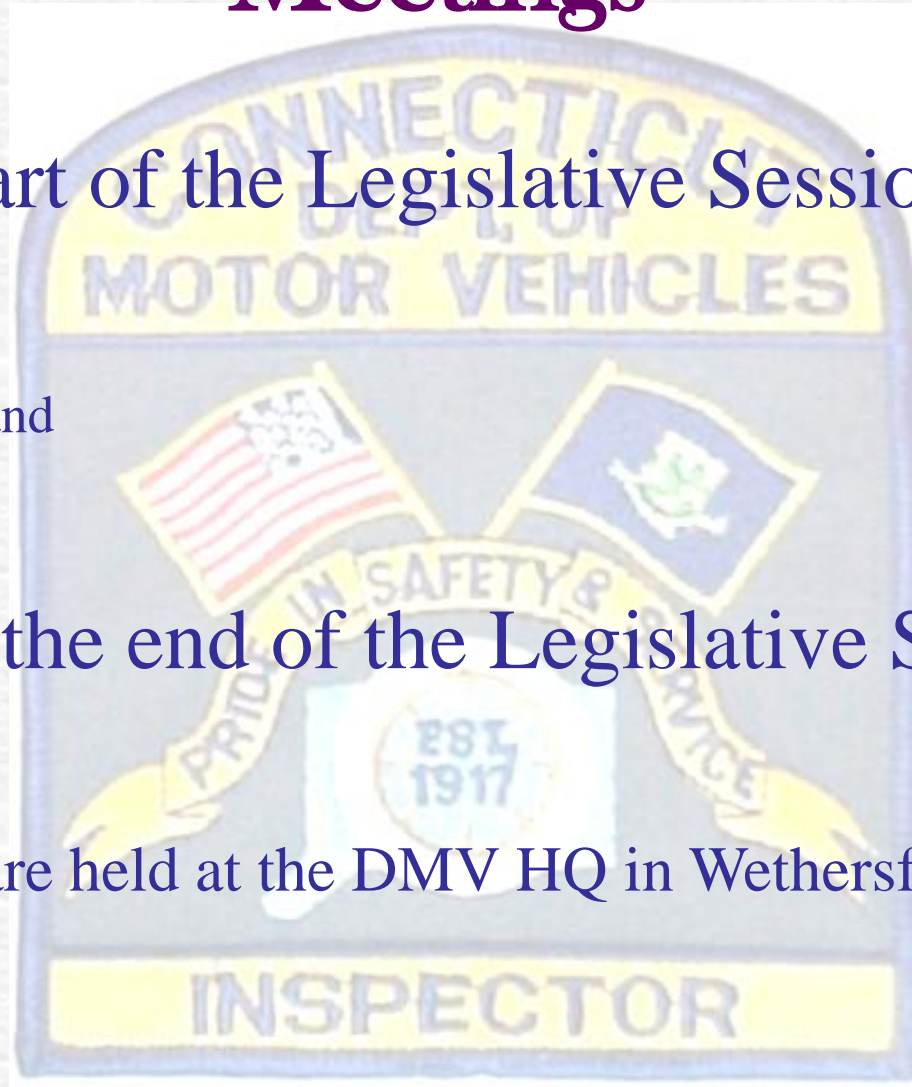
