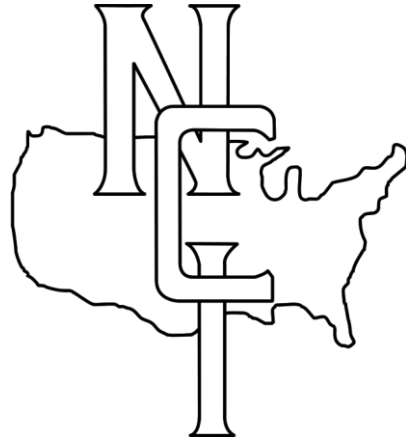

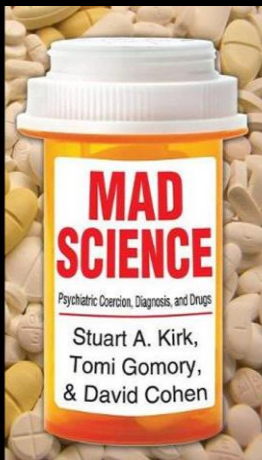

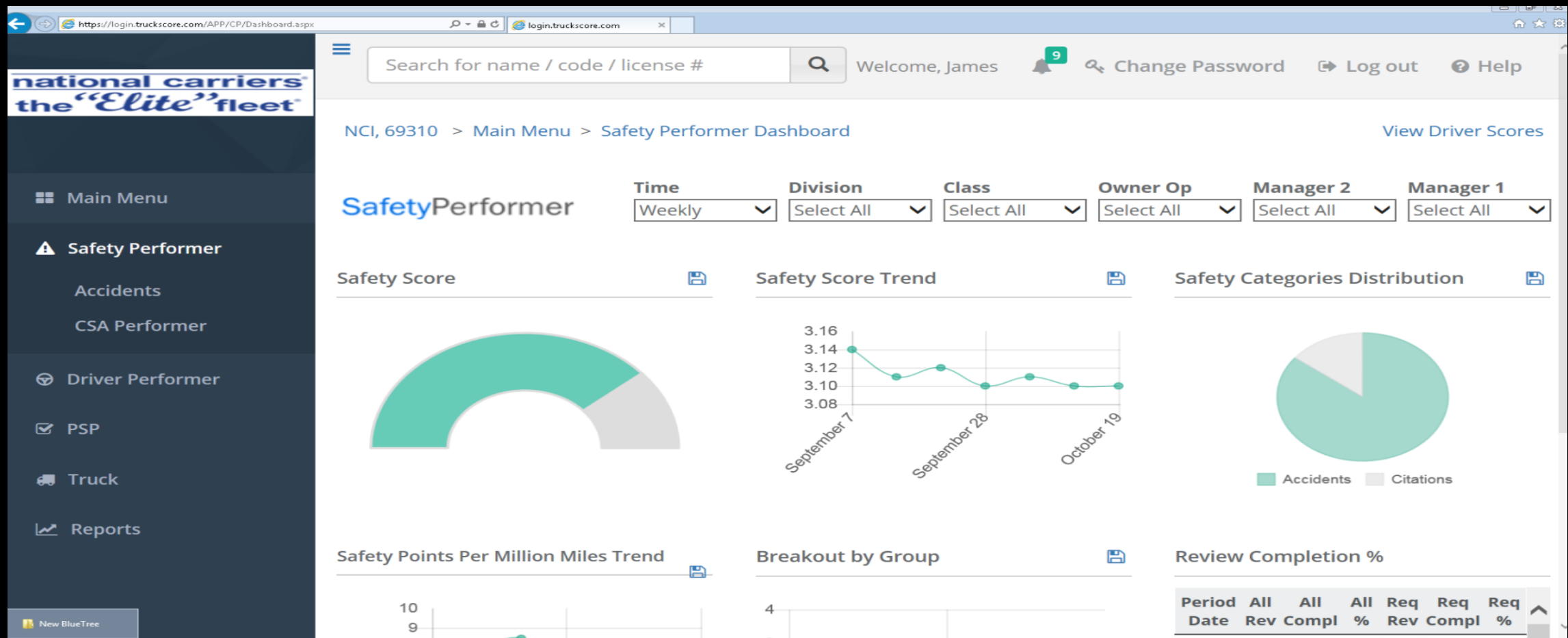

REMOTE VIEWING

We can track our trailer locations and temperatures every 5 minutes. We can even set the temperatures remotely if an order setting is different from what is being reported by the refrigerated unit.
