Scope of Trafficking

There are over **40 million** victims of human trafficking globally. (*International Labor Organization*)



Human trafficking happens in **all 50 states**, including D.C. (*National Human Trafficking Resource Center*)



A victim may be forced to have sex up to **20 times** a day. (*Polaris*)



Human trafficking is a **\$150 billion** criminal enterprise. (*International Labor Organization*)

Thousands of children are at risk of being prostituted in the US each year. (*National Center for Missing and Exploited Children*)




TAT's Mission

Ensure all **school bus** drivers are trained with **BOTL materials** by coordinating with the proper agency.






